A KIND ACT FOR HEARING IMPAIRED

On the morning of October 19th, 2019, the Center for Research and Education of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (CED) held a hearing care program: ears test, tympanometry measurement and hearing test for 39 children and the staff of Binh An Development Center. The program was led by Ms. Hanh Duong, Founder/ Executive Director of CED, and assisted by five members of the CED staff, as well as Doctor Minh Hoang from District 4 Hospital, and Ms. Tram Nguyen, a nurse from University Medical Center.

Ms. Hanh Duong said that she has lived with hearing loss since she was six years old. Despite this adversity, she made her best efforts in her studies and earned master degrees in both Education and Chemical Engineering from the University of Social Sciences and Humanities and the Ho Chi Minh City University of Technology, respectively. After her graduation, she volunteered at Disability Research and Capacity Development Deaf (DRD) - a non-government organization. Due to her hearing loss, she found difficulties in fulfilling her work. She then attended a project called "World Flight for Hearing" conducted by Johan Hammarstrom, a hearing impaired Swedish pilot. This project advocates concern, love, compassion, and support for each and every person with hearing impairment. Ms. Hanh's burning desire to serve people with hearing loss was motivated by the pilot's good deeds and advocacy.

In 2011, Ms. Hanh founded the Center for Research and Education of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing to serve people suffering from deafness and hearing loss. There are currently 10 staff members, 28 students, and volunteers at the center.

The FFSC would like to express our deep gratitude to Ms. Duong Hanh, Doctor Minh Hoang, Ms. Tram Nguyen, and the CED's staff for coming to the center and providing us the Hearing Care Program. We wish you good health, happiness, and success.

TEACHER APPRECIATION DAY




