Early in the morning, the students were present at the meeting point to move from the city to Long Thanh - Dong Nai Province. As soon as the camp commenced, the campers enjoyed a game of decoding letters.





In the afternoon, the students had a chance to change the atmosphere with folk games.



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At the end of the afternoon, the campers met Mr. and Mrs. Maclaurin, who are their main sponsors. 10 years ago (2011), Mr. and Mrs. Maclaurin established a scholarship fund to sponsor students with difficult circumstances in Ho Chi Minh City. Together with FFSC, they always accompany and visit the students every time they meet and award scholarships. They always listen and encourage students to continue spreading positive actions in the community. The students also love to talk to and listen to Mr. Maclaurin's own experiences as the director of the Premier Oil Company.

Among the scholarship students, there are currently some students working part-time jobs by driving a technology vehicle (Grab) to cover their studies. Although life is difficult, they all want to continue learning and fulfilling their dreams. Le Thi Anh Ly - a former student who received a scholarship from the program shared: When I was in college, my family had economic difficulties, I intend to quit school. Thanks to a referral, I got a scholarship to continue my dream. I was touched to say that I have conditions in the future, I will spend a small amount of money to help difficult students.



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On behalf of the students, Ms. Thanh Hường – scholarship manager, thanked Mr. and Mrs. Maclaurin for supporting the students during the past 10 years (2011-2021). The total number of students receiving scholarships from 2011- 2021 was 228, 162 students have graduated, 12 students have dropped out of school. In the academic year 2020 – 2021, there are 52 students receiving scholarships. Including 8 scholarships from Leon organization and 1 scholarship from Co Ba Nguyet (USA). The most meaningful moment was at the end of the camp, the trainees gathered near the warm fire to share their feelings and listen to each other's experiences, especially the alumni who were in the initial period of a start-up.

The camp was over. Amongst the busy pace of life and studying and making a living, everyone needs a place to stop, to grow up and mature. Training

he FFSC office has long been considered the meeting place of Japanese women. For many years, this place has been welcoming many groups from the land of cherry blossoms. They came to research about the program's activities for the care and education of poor children and had many concrete and meaningful support ways.

Currently, the number of benefactors in Japan supports scholarships to 80 poor children in need. Every year, a group of Japanese dentists comes to Binh Trieu Center to take care of their children's teeth. In addition, there is a Japanese volunteer living in Vietnam to teach Japanese at Binh Tho Center.

In particular, at the FFSC office, there are 3 Japanese women volunteering for the office. Those are silent jobs such as welcoming guests, answering emails or emails, translating documents, writing letters and newsletters of the program. Doing all these seem to be regular and boring, but they always do it carefully with a high sense of responsibility.
